Let's go for a bite!



Role 1: Imagine you are a waiter in a restaurant. When people sit down at the table, you have to give them the menus and take their orders.

Role 2: Imagine you are a customer in a restaurant. You sit down at the table with a partner and order some food.

Here is a sample conversation. Read it and take inspiration for your role-play!

Sample Conversation: Ordering Food at the Restaurant

Waiter: Welcome to Uncle Tom's. Here are your menus. Today's special is chicken salad. I'll be back to take your order in a few minutes.

Waiter: Are you ready to order?

Customer A: Yes, *I'd like* the chicken salad.

Waiter: And you?

Customer B: I'll *have* a cheeseburger and fries.

Waiter: Would you like anything to drink?

Customer A: I'll have mineral water, please.

Waiter: And for you?

Customer B: A coke, please.

Waiter: Ok. So that's a chicken salad, a cheeseburger and fries, one coke, and one water.

...

Waiter: Here is your food. Enjoy your meal.

...

Waiter: How was everything?

Customers B: Delicious, thanks!

Waiter: Would you like anything for dessert?

Customer A: Yes, can we take a look at the menu, please?

Waiter: Of course, here is the menu.

Customer A: I'll have a cheesecake.

Waiter: What about you, sir?

Customer B: I'll have a pumpkin pie, thanks.

Waiter: Ok, I'll be back in a minute.

...

Waiter: here are your desserts.

Customer B: Thanks. Can we have the bill, please?

Waiter: Sure. Here is the bill.

Customer A: Can we pay by credit card?

Waiter: Of course.

Customer A: Thanks a lot

- the food is cold;
- the food is burnt;
- the food is too salty;
- the food is not cooked enough.
